DISTINGUISHING CHARACTER OF ROSES -

Exhibition blooms are Hybrid Tea Roses which are more than half open. They are large roses which have a single bloom on a head and no side buds. Decorative blooms are long slender blooms which are from quarter to half open with no side buds. A stem is a rose with more than one open flower and buds.
